1. Last date for submission of Online Application: **10.01.2017** up to **2330 Hrs** (Indian Standard Time) only.
2. Applications shall be accepted online only through the website of the Hospital www.rgssh.in. Recruitment rules and other details are available on the hospital website.
3. No application will be accepted by hand/in person.
4. Applications lacking complete information as per the prescribed proforma and non-remittance of requisite application fee will be rejected without any further communication..
5. The appointment for the posts of Medical Superintendent and Medical Officer is purely contractual in nature and is not pensionable. Regarding salary the circular/order of Delhi Government shall be followed in respect of the contractual appointment. The appointment for the posts of Senior Resident and Junior Resident is as per the Residency Scheme of Delhi Govt.
6. One post of Medical Officer, Two Posts of Senior Resident and Two Posts of Junior Resident is reserved for DIVYANG (Physical Handicapped) candidates.
7. In addition to two posts of SR (Pulmonology) as mentioned at S.No. 11, additional 05 posts of SR (Pulmonology) are also to be filled on ad-hoc basis as mentioned at S.No. 12 which will be selected as per the same merit list prepared after filling up of above 02 contractual posts of SR (Pulmonology).
8. The selected Candidate for the post of Medical Superintendent shall be appointed initially for a period of one year further extendable up to a maximum of five years on the basis of satisfactory performance appraisal report with inter-alia a notice period of three months from either side for severance of contract.
9. The selected Candidates for the post of Medical Officer shall be appointed initially for a period of one year further extendable upto a maximum of five years on the basis of satisfactory performance appraisal report with inter-alia a notice period of one month from either side for severance of contract.
10. The selected Candidates for the post of Senior Residents shall be appointed initially for a period of one year further extendable upto a maximum of three years on the basis of satisfactory performance appraisal report with inter-alia a notice period of one month from either side for severance of contract.
11. The selected Candidates for the post of Junior Residents shall be appointed for a period of one year with inter-alia a notice period of one month from either side for severance of contract.
12. The period of service rendered by a candidate as Medical Superintendent, Medical Officer, Senior Resident and Junior Resident in Govt. Hospitals/Autonomous Bodies funded by the Govt./Private Nursing Homes prior to this appointment, if any, will count while reckoning the tenure as Medical Officer, Senior Resident and Junior Resident. An undertaking in this regard is to be furnished with acceptance letter along with documentary proof.
13. If it is learnt at any stage that false information has been furnished in the application form or that there has been suppression of any material information, then it shall lead to disqualification of the Candidature and liable to be removed from service forthwith and may invite appropriate action against the applicant.
14. Date for determining the age for the Candidate shall be the last date of receipt of application.
15. Non refundable application fee of Rs.500/- for unreserved & OBC candidates and Rs.100/- for SC/ST candidates should be submitted online only along with the application form. DIVYANG (Physical Handicapped) candidates are exempted from payment of fee.
16. The selected candidate must be registered with Delhi Medical Council at the time of joining.
17. Applicants, who do not possess requisite qualifications as on the last date for submission of applications, shall not be considered and their application shall be rejected summarily. No separate intimation of rejection shall be intimated to rejected candidates.
18. Age relaxation is applicable upto 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates (belonging to Delhi only) as per Govt. of NCT of Delhi/GOI rules. For DIVYANG (Physical Handicapped) candidate age relaxation is upto 10 years as per Govt. of NCT of Delhi/GOI rules.

19. Candidates seeking benefits of reservation under SC/ST/OBC/ DIVYANG categories shall produce the relevant certificates (issued before the date of advertisement) issued by competent Authority of GNCTD. The OBC inclusion shall only be as per current GNCT of Delhi list which is available on Delhi Government Website.
20. DIVYANG (Physical Handicapped) candidates are required to produce the physically handicapped certificate (with degree of disability) in original issued by the Competent Authority (i.e. Medical Board duly constituted by Central Govt. or State Govt.) at the time of interview.
21. DIVYANG (Physical Handicapped) candidates are encouraged to apply for the other posts also, not earmarked for them, if they are fulfilling the required qualifications.
22. The applicants should not have been convicted by any Court of Law. If the applicant is facing any legal proceeding, the same shall be declared by providing information of the same.
23. Canvassing in any form shall lead to immediate disqualification of the Candidature.
24. The candidates while appearing for Interview shall be required to produce all relevant original documents along with one copy of self-attested photocopies of all testimonial/certificates and one passport size photograph.
25. The decision of the Selection Board regarding selection of the candidates shall be final and no representation shall be entertained in this regard.
26. In the case of exceptionally deserving candidates, the Institute reserves the right of granting relaxation in qualification/experience/age.
27. The Hospital reserves the right to change the number of vacancies, withdraw the process (in full or in part) and also right to reject any or all applications received without assigning any reasons or giving notice etc.
28. The Hospital authorities reserves the right to assign any related additional work, if required. No extra remuneration will be paid in this regard.
