- 4. In addition to two posts of SR (Pulmonology) as mentioned at S.No. 11, additional 05 posts of SR (Pulmonology) are also to be filled on ad-hoc basis as mentioned at S.No. 12 which will be selected as per the same merit list prepared after filling up of above 02 contractual posts of SR (Pulmonology).
- 5. The selected Candidates for the post of Senior Residents shall be appointed initially for a period of one year further extendable upto a maximum of three years on the basis of satisfactory performance appraisal report with inter-alia a notice period of one month from either side for severance of contract.
